#### Lobby Renovations Mean 'Brighter' Days Ahead at 200 South Wacker

There's a "brighter" future in store for 200 South Wacker tenants and visitors beginning next spring, following completion of a major lobby renovation project that will introduce a vibrant new look for the building's largest common area.

The focal point of the new lobby, designed by Wright Heerema Architects, will be a "feature wall" comprised of customizable back-lit color squares. The squares will replace the glass poppies that have been on display for nearly 10 years.

These upgrades – which include creation of a new exterior canopy over the main entrance – comprise the first major renovation of the building's lobby since 2012. However, one important feature will not change: the space's abundance of natural lighting.

"When completed, the new lobby will more accurately reflect 200 South Wacker's longstanding commitment to helping our tenants embrace a brighter, better future," Property Manager Lisa Metz, RPA, explained. "We are proud to partner with Wright Heerema, a firm that has built its name on delivering well-designed, appealing spaces for countless commercial and corporate facilities,

and are extremely excited to reap the benefits of their work," she added.
